#### The Cahaba River

The Cahaba is home to globally-significant freshwater wildlife, with more species of fish per mile than any other river in North America. The Cahaba River is vitally important to the communities in its watershed, including parts of Alabama's Jefferson, Shelby, Bibb, Perry and Dallas Counties. It is the main drinking water source for the Birmingham Water Works Board service area, which serves about one-fifth of Alabamians. This "peopleshed" of residents and businesses who depend upon the Cahaba River encompasses over a million people.

Founded in 1988, CAHABA RIVER SOCIETY is an educator, expert resource, and collaborative partner working to protect and restore the Cahaba River watershed and its rich diversity of life. With core values of integrity, education, collaboration, equity, diversity & inclusion, and stewardship, we combine expertise in river ecosystems with a practical understanding of the forces of urban growth, collaborate to increase partnerships and resources for meeting the Cahaba's challenges, and encourage people to become caring and connected stewards for their community's water resources.


